From North: Take Route 94 South to White Lake Road, turn left at blinker light then left into ETTC parking lot. The lab entrance doors are on the extreme right as you face the building. Enter the building, the ETTC Lab is directly on your right.

From South: Follow Route 94 North. At the junction of Route 94 and Route 15 in Sparta, take the jug handle on right after intersection to stay on Route 94 North. Continue to the first blinker light, White Lake Road and make a right turn, then take the first left into the parking lot. The lab entrance doors are on the extreme right as you face the building. Enter the building, the ETTC Lab is directly on your right.

From the East: Follow Route 15 North to White Lake Road. Turn right at the traffic light. Follow White Lake Road to the parking lot on your right at Sussex County Technical School. Turn right into the parking lot. The lab entrance doors are on the extreme right as you face the building. Enter the building, the ETTC Lab is directly on your right.

From the West: Follow either Route 15 South, or Route 94 North to the junction of both roads in Sparta. At the junction of Route 94 and Route 15 in Sparta, take the jug handle on right after intersection to stay on Route 94 North. Continue to the first blinker light, White Lake Road and make a right turn, then take the first left into the parking lot. The lab entrance doors are on the extreme right as you face the building. Enter the building, the ETTC Lab is directly on your right.

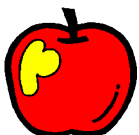
